

GOOD INTERNSHIPS – Improving Professional Competencies of the UWr Students Through Their Participation in High-Quality Internship Programmes

The aim of the paid professional internships is to allow each Trainee to acquire knowledge about how business entities operate, as well as gain professional experience in key areas, facilitating entry into the labour market through, among other things, learning about own professional aptitude and combining theoretical knowledge acquired during the studies with practical skills.

Areas of support:

- 120-hour internships
- internship grant to the amount of 18,50 PLN gross per hour
- insurance against accidents for the duration of the internship
- tutor at the place where the internship is conducted

Who can apply?

- students of the 2nd year of the first-cycle **Bachelor of Business and Administration** programme
- students of the 2nd year of the second-cycle **International and European Law** programme

First internships will start in May 2018.
